 - Receiving positive feedback from priority Dispatch on our Quality Improvement Coordinator's (Mike Cochran) reviews. 80% accuracy is expected and Mr. Cochran is meeting and exceeding this standard.
- Medical Control/ Fire Agencies
 - The Fire Committee reviewed each protocol down to the suffix to determine specific fire response codes and also consulted with Dr. Kemple on clarification on certain EMS response codes.
 - As issues arise, they are addressed and revised through the committee.
- Dispatcher Training Funds
 - Application process is open and the deadline is January 30, 2026.
 - All of our 2023 funds are expended which is a requirement to apply for 2026 funds.
 - Funds are used for dispatcher continued education, emergency fire and dispatch continued education, medical dispatch continued education and state required training.
- General Retention Schedule
 - 911 Audio is currently at a 1-year retention schedule.
 - General Retention Schedule, which we follow, will move it to 90 days.
 - The 911 Board moved it to have a special schedule to reflect the original retention schedule.
 - The schedule was drafted for final review and approval at the next 911 Board Meeting for submission to the State.

X. OLD BUSINESS—

1. EMA-MCA Agreement Update

Chairman Brown explained they haven't closed the review for 2025. They are still working on issues trying to make the report as feasible as possible. Chairman Brown informed municipalities to let them know if there are concerns and to not wait until January. Chairman Brown explained informing them of concerns year-round would be best so they can be addressed quicker.

XI. NEW BUSINESS—

1. Medical Directors Award

Dr. Kemple awarded the Medical Directors Award to Deputy Lidell. Dr. Kemple explained Deputy Lidell was instrumental in saving a patient's life. On September 16th a patient was having an allergic reaction and was unconscious, unresponsive, and barely breathing. Deputy Lidell took the initiative of responding to the scene and administered his own EpiPen. By the time the patient was in the hospital they were breathing and talking on their own. Dr. Kemple stated without a doubt, this Deputy saved this patient's life. Honored Deputy Lidell for his actions, initiatives, and quick thinking. Dr. Kemple presented the Medical Directors Award to Deputy Lidell.

2. Update by MCA—Karl Rock gave the report

- This month we are participating in a couple special events, like the tree lighting this Friday. We will also be at the Ida Parade and Mr. Rock stated it is one of the best parades in the Country.
- Good news is the staffing has been approved and we've done a great job at retaining and developing the people we have.
- We have 2 new paramedics and 4 that are finishing the testing process.
- Recently promoted 4 existing paramedics to senior status.
- Going into January of 2026 we should hopefully be fully staffed.
- Recently deployed new AED's and BLS units and explained they have a lot of connectivity with the cloud.

Brian Paules told Mr. Rock congratulations. The data that the Operations Committee reviews and the reports that are generated definitely shows an increase in a positive fashion so congratulations to Eric Farris and the entire team for that.

Wendy Stevens explained she is trying to capture the amount of calls MCA transports out of Frenchtown right now. In September, MCA transported to Frenchtown 125 times and they transported 18 times. This means that 23% of the time, they were transporting. In March, they transported 16% of the time. Ms. Stevens stated they are trying to get the data read and get the numbers right so that they can give the Board accurate pictures of what is happening.

2. Medical Control Board Report – Dr. Kemple gave report

- State of Michigan required all MCA Directors to go to through training.
- Learned of new diagrams and explained the diagram in front of the Board are all the County's EMS calls that resulted in transport over the last 6 months.
- Qutos to MCA, Bedford, and Frenchtown for helping when needed.
- By-laws changes coming soon. The Medical Control Board is supposed to be 51% hospital. As of right now, the medical control board and advisory board have been combined into one.
- Three options: cut some non-hospital members and get more hospital members, separate the Medical Control Board into the control and advisory board again, or separate the boards and delegate authority to the advisory board to approve protocols.
- Explained there in nothing that restricts members from being on both boards.
- Dr. Kemple is going to use biospatial to pull some QA QI
- Added another option for basic pediatric emergency courses that supplement paramedic certification. The APC course supersedes what you would learn from PALS or PEPP (other courses).

Dr. Kemple said Happy Thanksgiving and Merry Christmas.
