Operations

Staff: We are currently staffed with 14 full-time supervisors and dispatchers and one temporary part-time dispatcher. We have three dispatch trainees who started this month with a fourth starting December 16th. A fifth applicant is going through the pre-hire testing and additional applicants in backgrounds. We are still screening applicants for the one remaining positions. Start dates will be setback due to available trainers but we have an established list to move forward. The job posting has been suspended but we will continue to review any applications already submitted.

GIS: Address cleanup for new and existing addresses is a continuous process. Physical fire department reference maps have been completed and sent over to printing. Mr. Boudrie is actively working on hard copy maps for each school district that have provided them. There has been limited support from Central Square regarding direct access to CAD GIS to expedite the process of updating CAD related map files. Mr. Boudrie has also been working with Central Square to resolve a CAD access issue due to GIS software incompatibility. Our software is more advanced and would require us to downgrade to obtain map access in the CAD. This is specific to Mr. Boudrie only and does not affect any other CAD user to my knowledge. As a work around an additional PC was acquired with the downgraded software.

Quality Improvement:

The Dispatch Review and Steering Committees have been established. The first Review Committee meeting was November 19th. Meetings will be held bi-monthly.

Director's Report

The Quality Improvement Coordinator has provided the attached Quality Improvement Reports for September and October with a summary overview. Additionally, there is information pertaining to a pending law enforcement call study that was completed.

Quality Performance Review (QPR) – Review personnel has been assigned by Priority Dispatch. There have been some technology issues we are troubleshooting with both our audio recording vendor NICE and Priority Dispatch. Once this has been resolved the QPR process will begin. This is a limited review to make sure Dispatch is on point with its reviews.

Records Retention – The State Records Retention Committee for 911 continues progress on the current review of the State's adopted General Retention Schedule #34 for Local 911 Centers. The schedule is in its final draft to be approved at the December meeting. Monroe County Central Dispatch uses this General Schedule #34 for its records management.

Statistics:

Non-Emergency Calls – Dispatch has received 76,214 non-emergency calls year to date. The average calls per month is 7621. The following graph shows a comparison of January through October totals from 2020-2024.

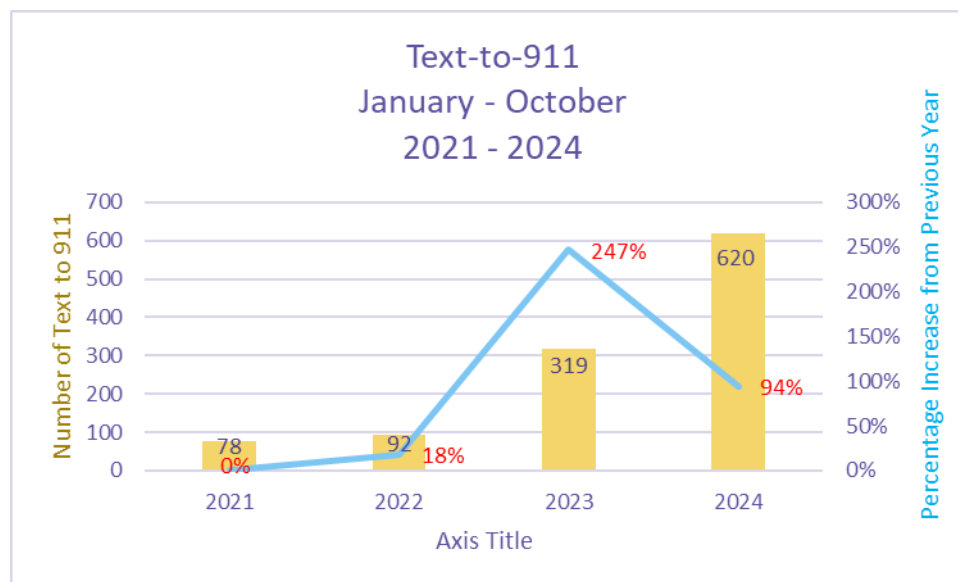

FOIA: As of November 18th, we have had 236 FOIA and/or audio requests from various agencies and the public. This is a 3% decrease in requests over this time last year.

Technology

911 Telephony – Installation of the new phone server and phone equipment is complete with the server cutover to occur within the next few weeks. Most of the cutover will occur in the background with little to no interruption to dispatch. The installation also included the addition of the call status lights which indicate if a dispatcher is on a 911 call, non-emergency line call, or available.

Flock License Plate Readers – The Flock System web access has been added to Dispatch. The Flock System alerts dispatchers when a Flock camera hits on a vehicle license plate associated with vehicles of interest that are flagged by law enforcement agencies. Vehicles of interest include those reported as stolen, stolen license plates, or vehicles linked to missing or wanted

persons. The dispatcher's role is to verify the alerted information with the information contained on the hot list. A BOL is put out to available officers and a Call for Service created in the CAD.

911 Partners and Stakeholders:

Medical Control/Fire Agencies - A Priority 3 Protocol Review was completed and approved. The changes were updated in the EMD Protocol effective September 26th.

Urban Areas Security Initiative (UASI)/Monroe County – The TIC Plan update remains a task list item. However, at the October 8th Detroit SE Michigan UASI Interoperability Committee Meeting the guidance was to hold off on any efforts regarding the TIC plan pending guidance from the State on a newer format or standard.

MPSCS – The countywide Integration Agreement- Phase I was approved by the Board of Commissioners on October 15th. Phase II is awaiting a Preventative Maintenance schedule from the MPSCS. Once that is established we can move forward with the Phase II Agreement which will require a separate resolution from the Board of Commissioners.

Local Planning Team – A Radio Encryption Committee was established under the Local Planning Team to discuss radio encryption. This topic is important to Dispatch as it relates to the Criminal Justice Information Services (CJIS) radio encryption requirements and complaint with the Law Enforcement Information Network (LEIN). Dispatch is working in coordination with other county department representatives to best address the current issues, best practices, and next steps with encryption.

Airport Community Schools – As part of their security systems, Airport Schools have implemented the total SmartBoot System. The SmartBoot System (through LockOut USA) consists of a door barricade or "Boot" made from 7/8" thick cold-rolled steel pins and can withstand 16,000 pounds of pressure when engaged. At minimum a "Boot" is placed in every classroom. Associated with the Boot is a tablet that may be placed in Dispatch. The tablet will send direct alerts to Dispatch that a school is on lockdown. I have been working with the LockOut representative to address questions, concerns, issues, expectations, mapping, liability, etc. regarding the system and implementation. These discussions are needed to create a new Dispatch policy and appropriate training prior to implementation.

QI Update

Monroe County Central Dispatch, for the period ending on October 31st, 2024, is eighty percent (80%) compliant (reviews graded at High Compliance and Compliant) in its use of the Emergency Medical Dispatch (EMD) Protocols. Nine percent (9%) of the calls reviewed fall as Non-Compliant. Quality Improvement (QI) looks at the trends that cause the calls to grade as less than compliant. Currently the issues causing those less than compliant grades are:

- Asking the protocol questions in the order they are presented.
- Asking questions that are not part of the scripted protocol questions.
- Not asking clarifying questions as complete questions.
- Asking the protocol questions in the correct area of the protocol.
- Not giving all the appropriate case exit instructions to the caller.

QI looks at the Dispatcher who is working the Fire Desk as they are taking a medical call to see if they follow the policy to pause their questioning when they reach the Send Point of a medical call to dispatch Fire and EMS. The agency is following the policy seventy-four percent (74%) of the time. QI also looks at the time a Dispatcher takes a call and reaches the Send Point of the call to when the Dispatcher working the Fire Desk dispatches the call. The average time between these events is 18.7 seconds.

Pending Law Call Study.

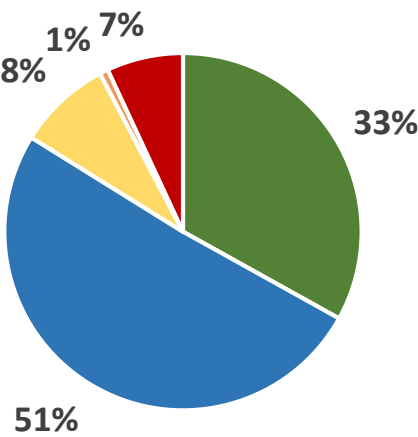
Following the last 9-1-1 board meeting's discussion on the pending times of law enforcement calls prior to dispatch, QI randomly selected a day and looked at what potentially is the cause of the lengthy call pending times. Randomly selecting Thursday October 3rd, 2024 from 7am to 7pm a timeline (attached) was created to look into this issue. The timeline is broken down into five-minute increments to show the on-duty officers (MCSO, MSP, and Municipal Departments) activities and compare them to the pending calls. The upside of this study was that calls for service (CFS) that were in-progress or high priority had a low pending time, compared to those calls that were low-priority or not-in-progress. It also shows that the main cause of a CFS to pend was there were not enough officers available to respond the volume of calls. This day the officers were running call to call for most of the day. When an in-progress call was broadcasted over the air, the officers would clear the calls they were currently on to respond. Along with this visual timeline, a spreadsheet (attached) was created to show all the CFS's for this same shift, its priority, the time it pended, and any special notes about the call. This spreadsheet showed that the majority of the CFS's were either officer-initiated or had no pending time.

While this study was very informational, it unfortunately is not a sustainable way to continue to look at the information. While an attempt was made to create a report that displayed the same information from the CAD Reporting Software, the filters that are built in to the system, and cannot be manipulated in a way to achieve the same results automatically. Therefore, QI had to spend 17 hours to search, pull and combine the information into the above report. Efforts to make a CAD report that mirrors the manual report are still being worked on, but are not ready at this time.

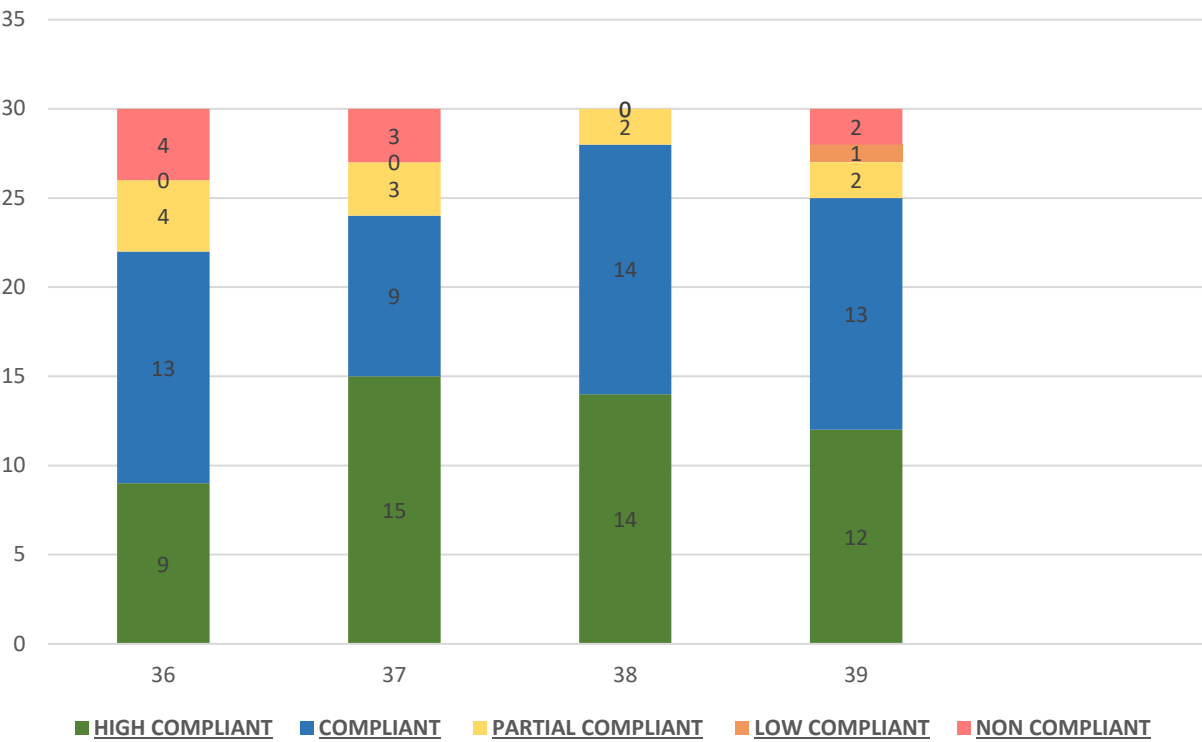

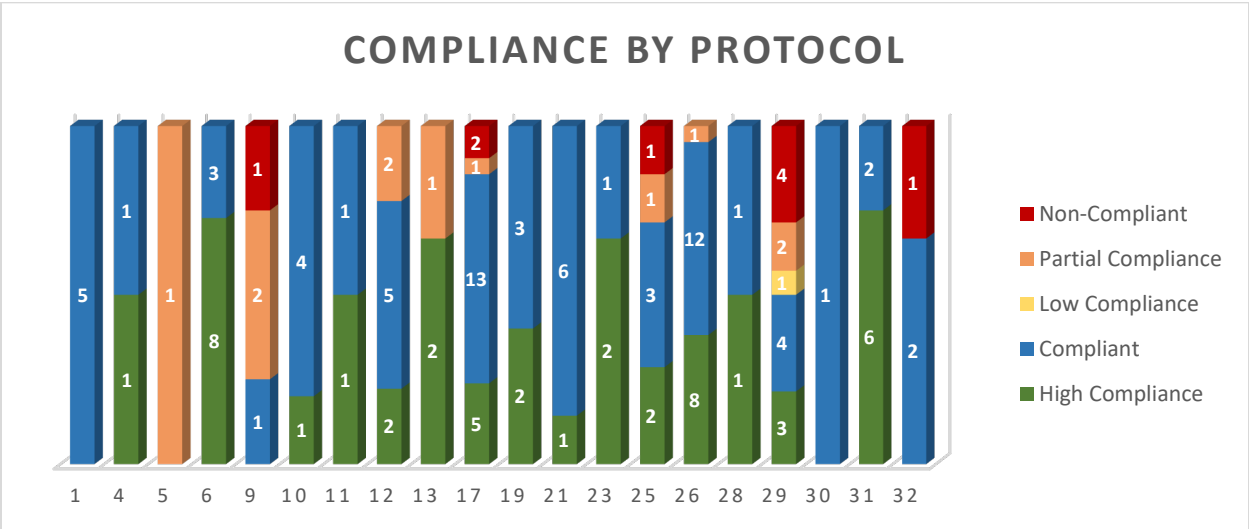
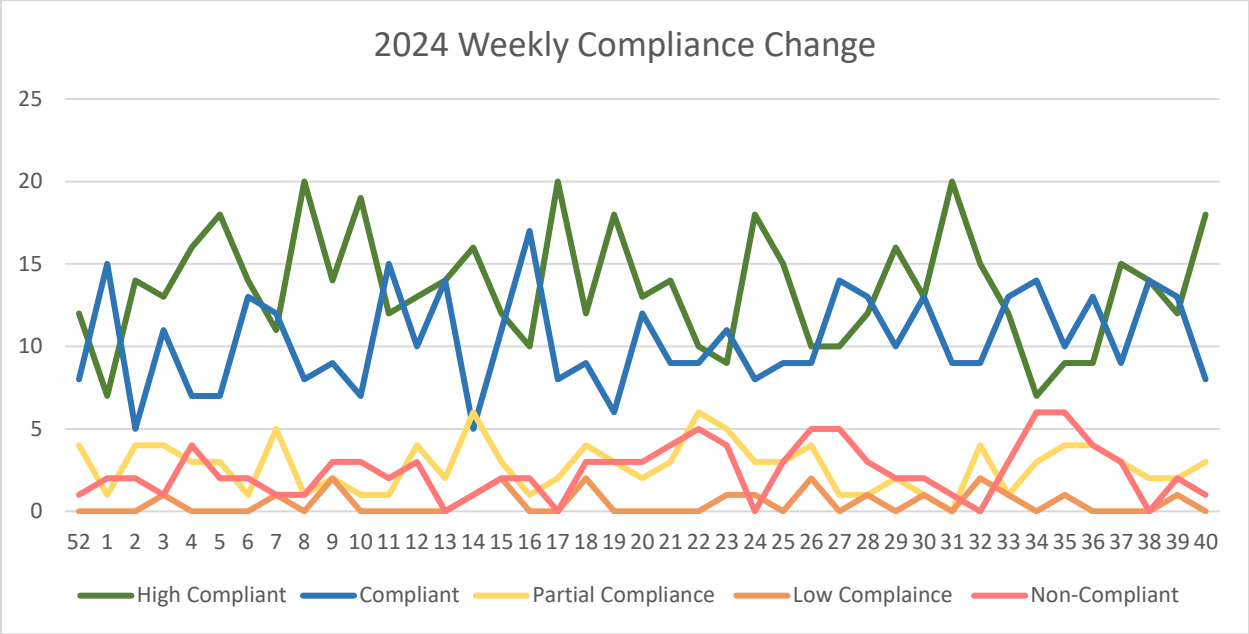
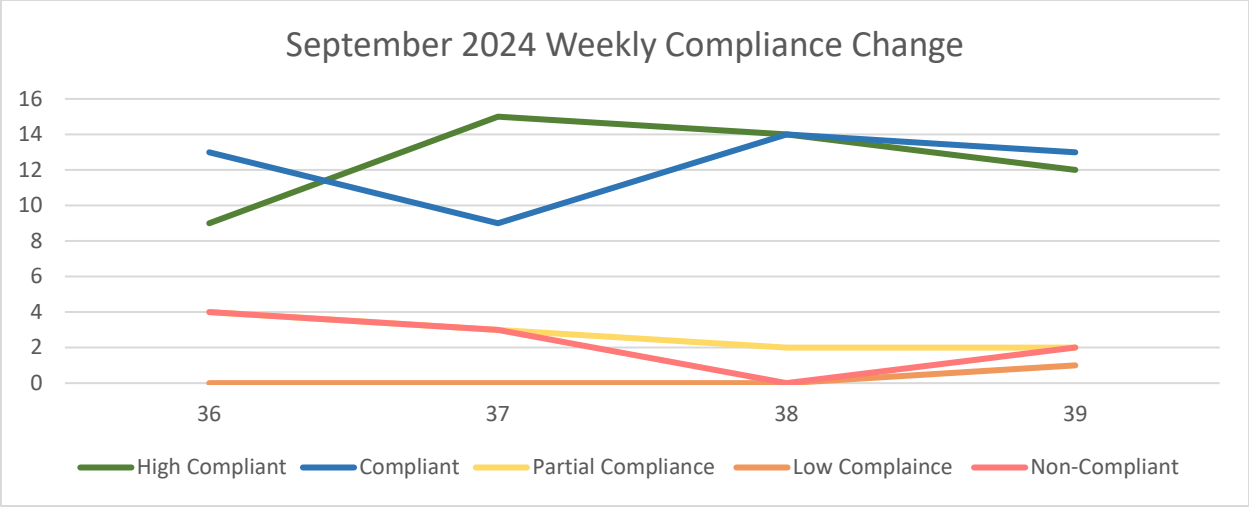
September 2024 Compliance Levels

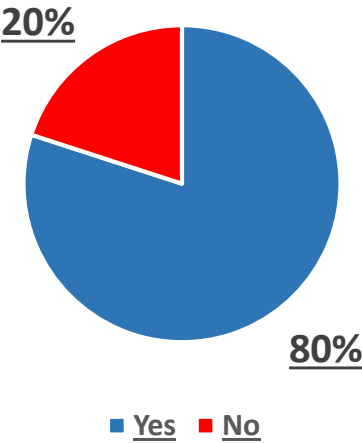


September 2024 Compliance Level by Week

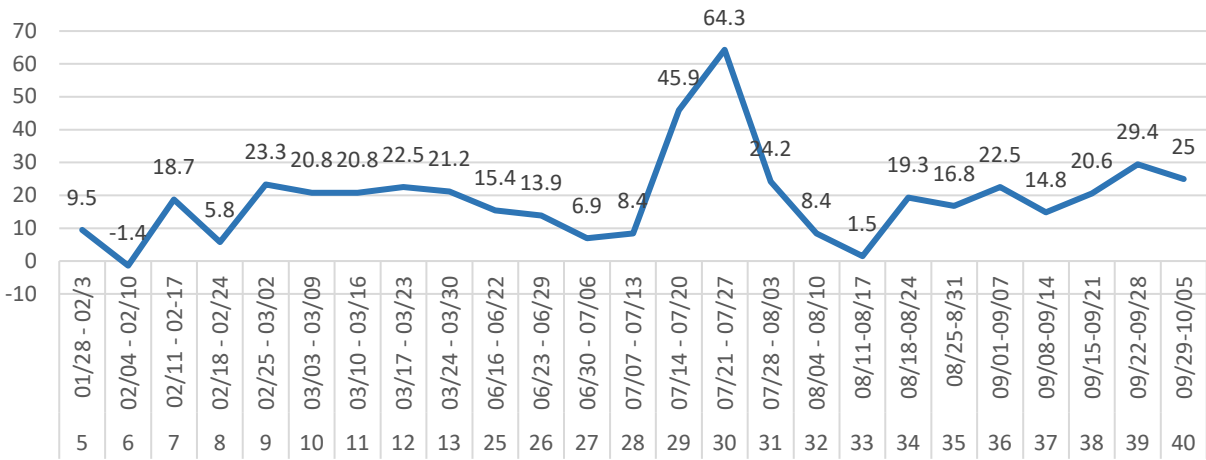




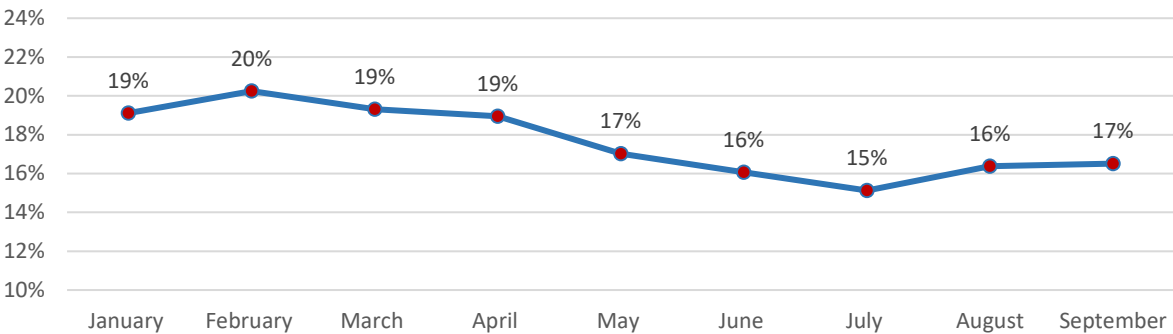
September Dispatch at Send Point



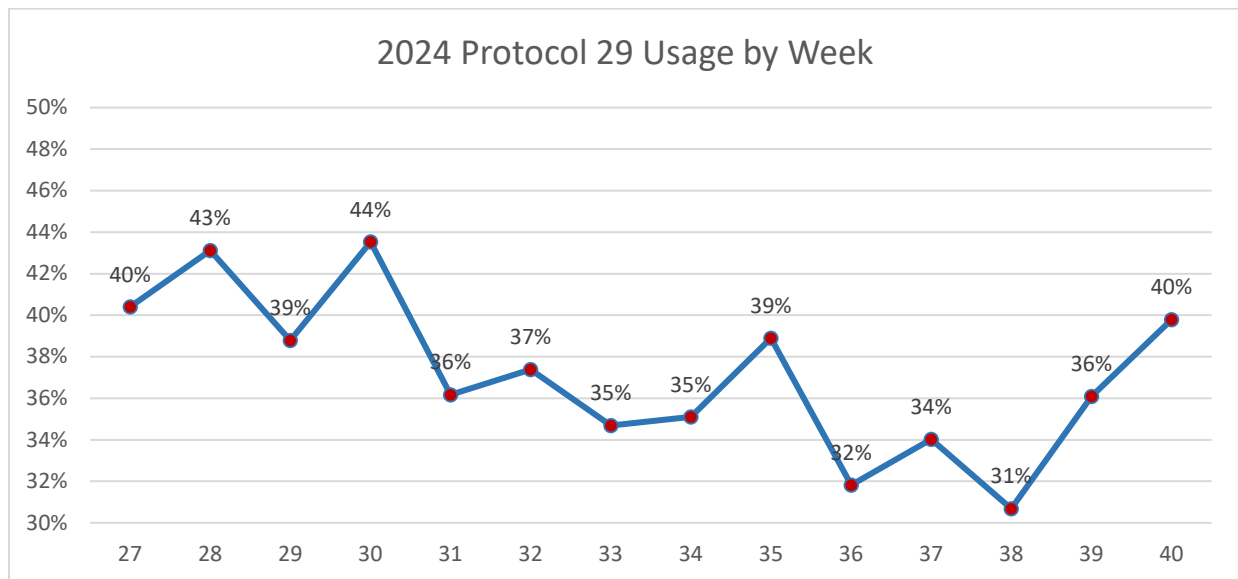
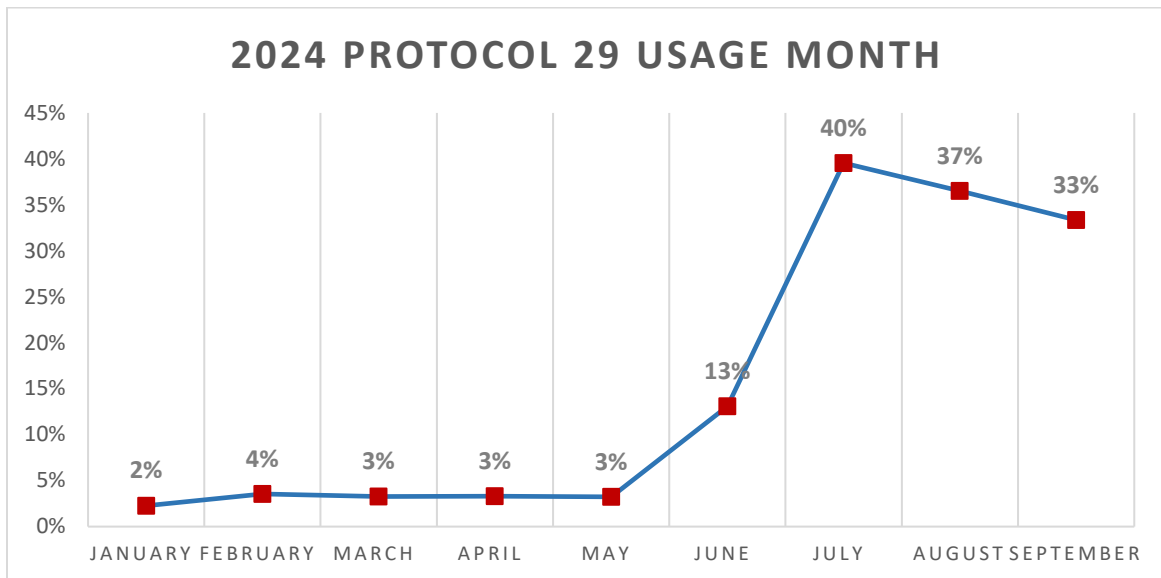
2024 Dispatch at Send (Non Call-Taker)



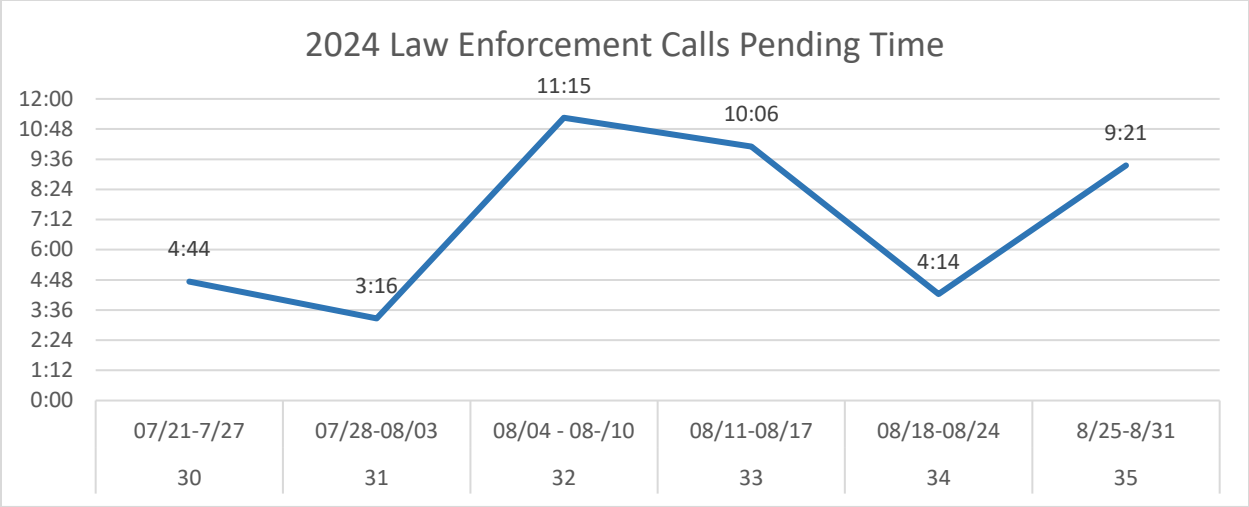
2024 Protocol 26 Usage by Month



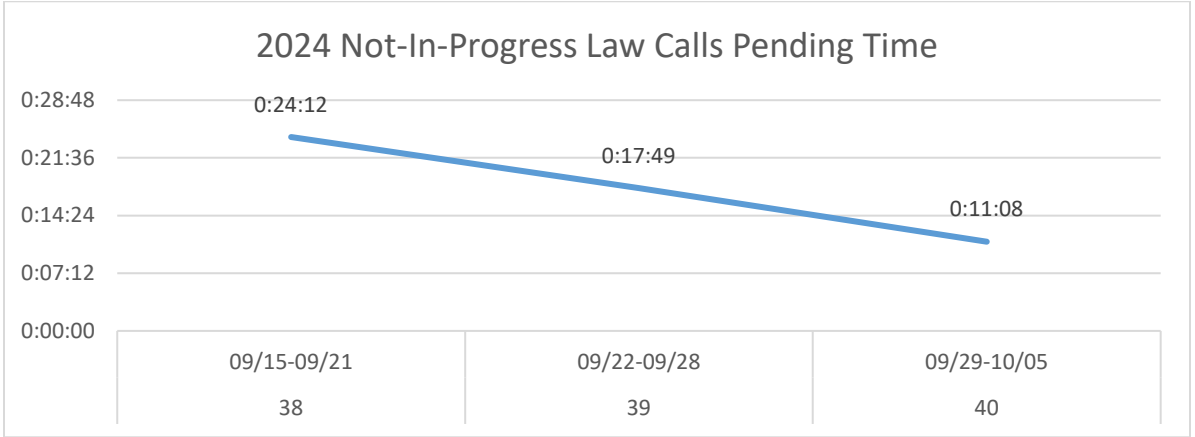
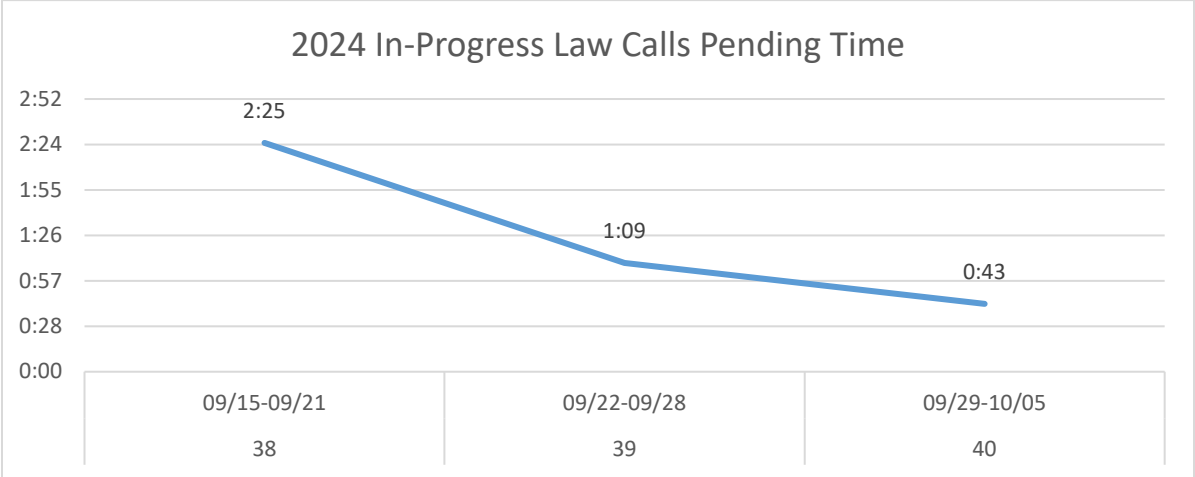
Still looking at what percentage of all the traffic incident calls that come into the center are utilizing EMD Protocol 29 as per the department's policy. I am continuing to review how long a Law Enforcement Call pended prior to being dispatched. The average time a call pended for the month of September was 12 minutes and 09 seconds.



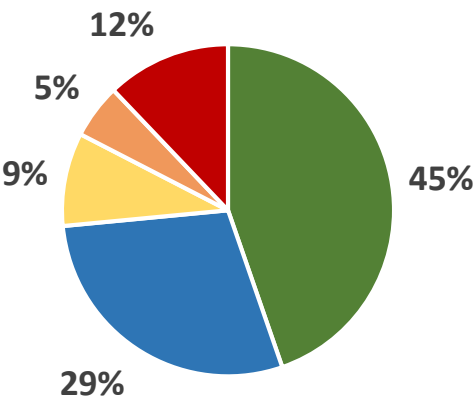

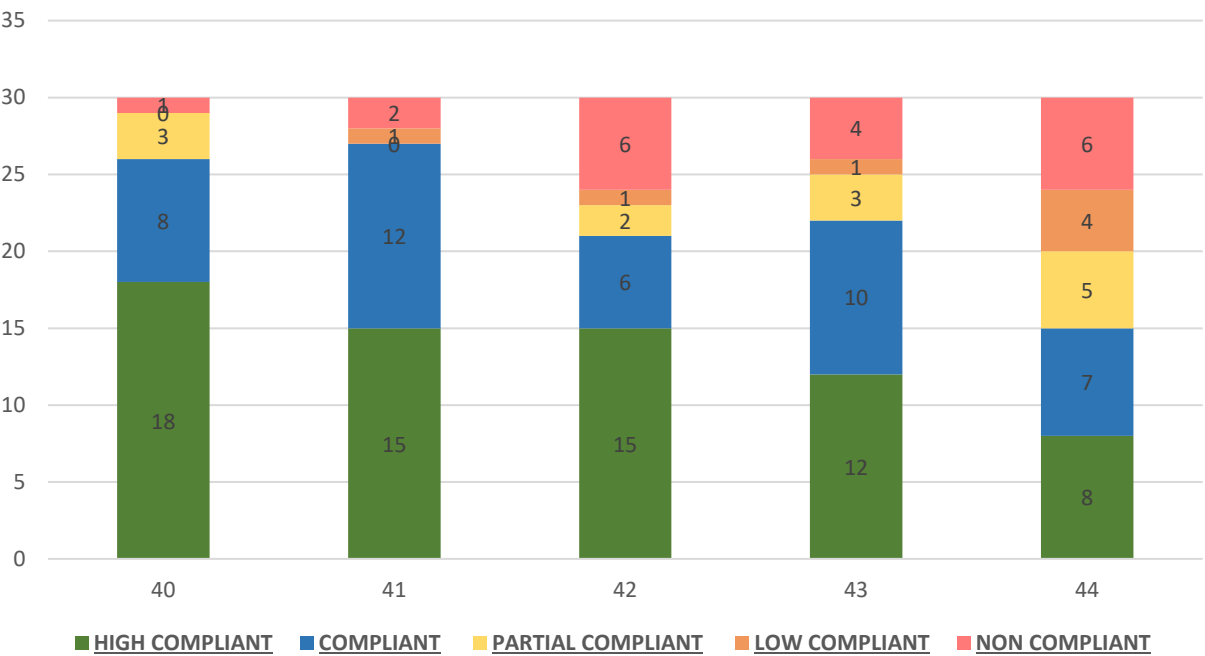
October 2024 Progress Report

October Compliance Levels

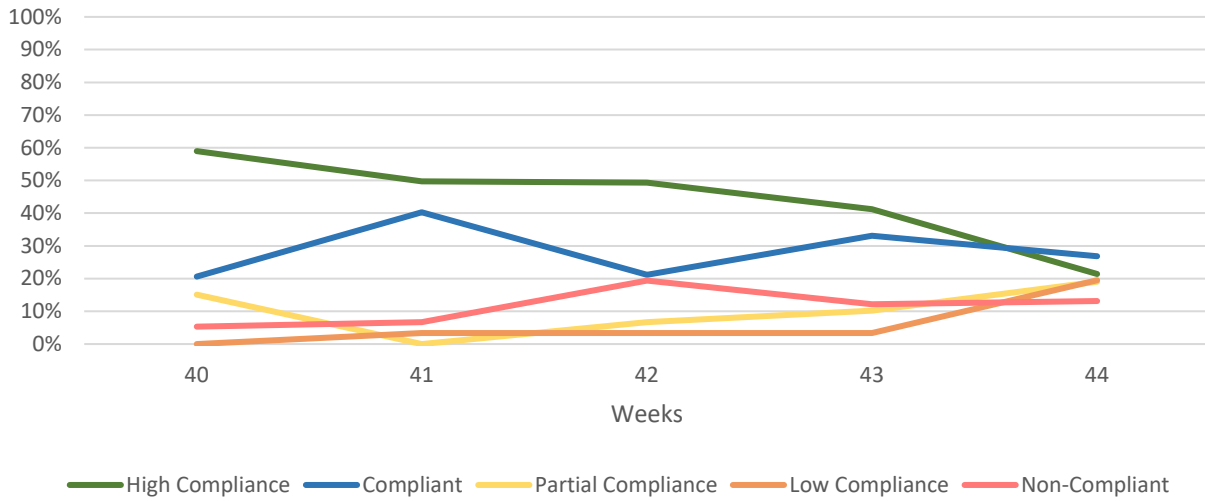

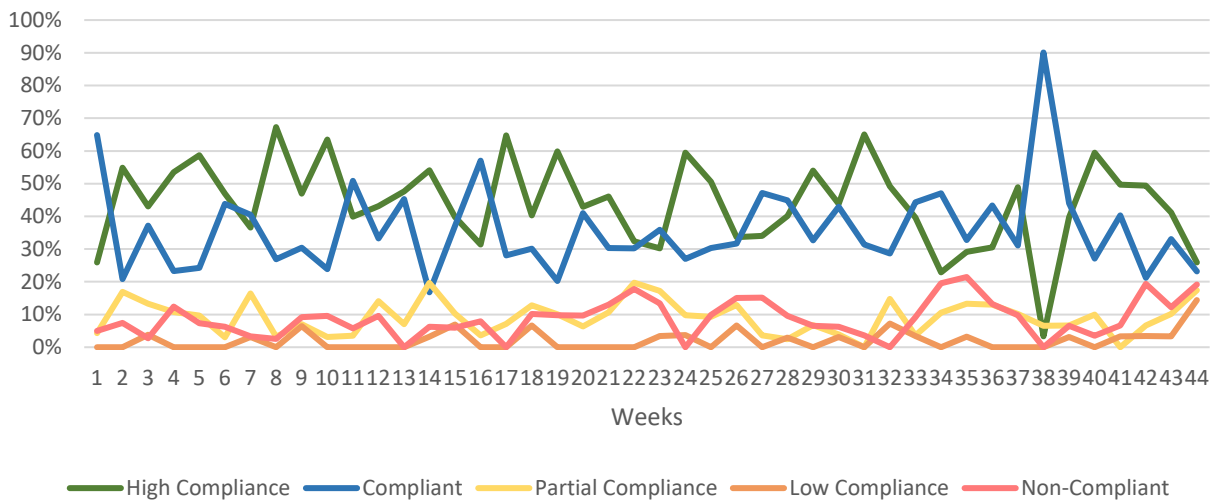
October 2024 Compliance Level by Week



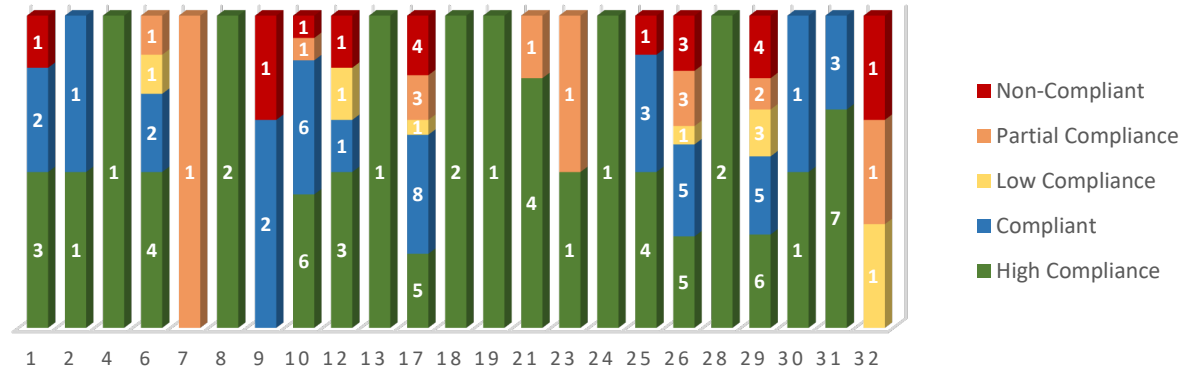
October 2024 Compliance Level Trends



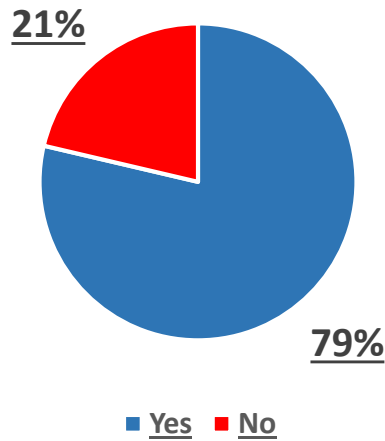

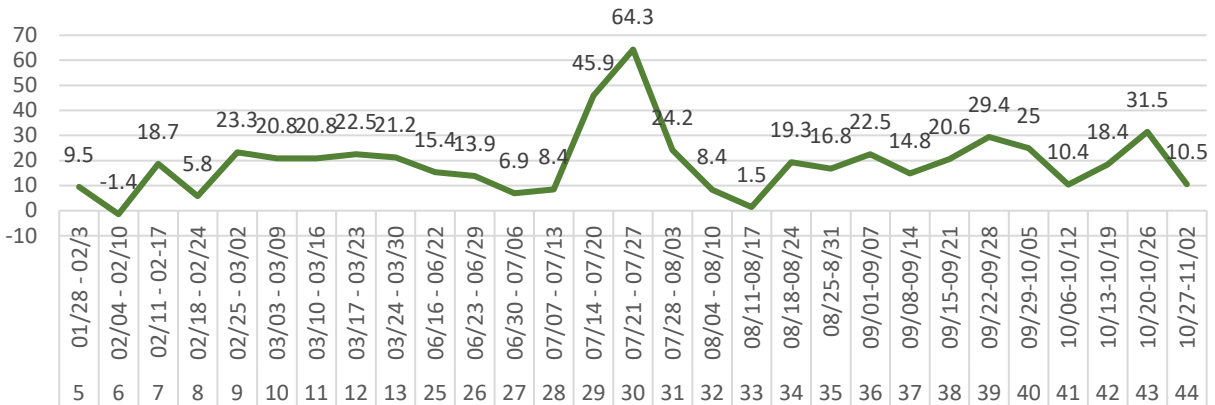

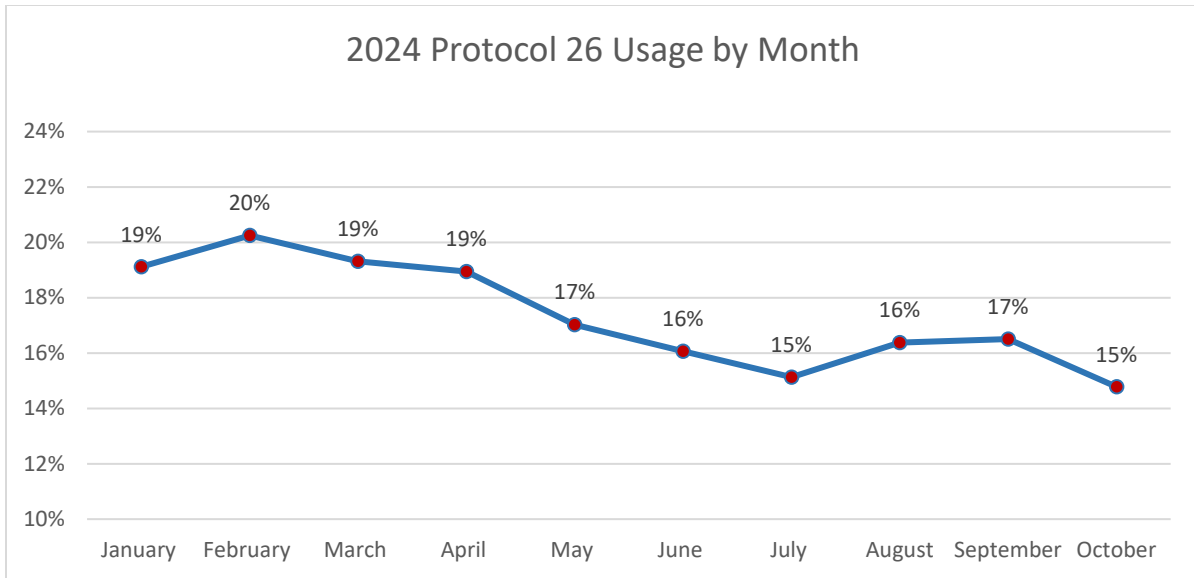


October 2024 Dispatch at the Send Point

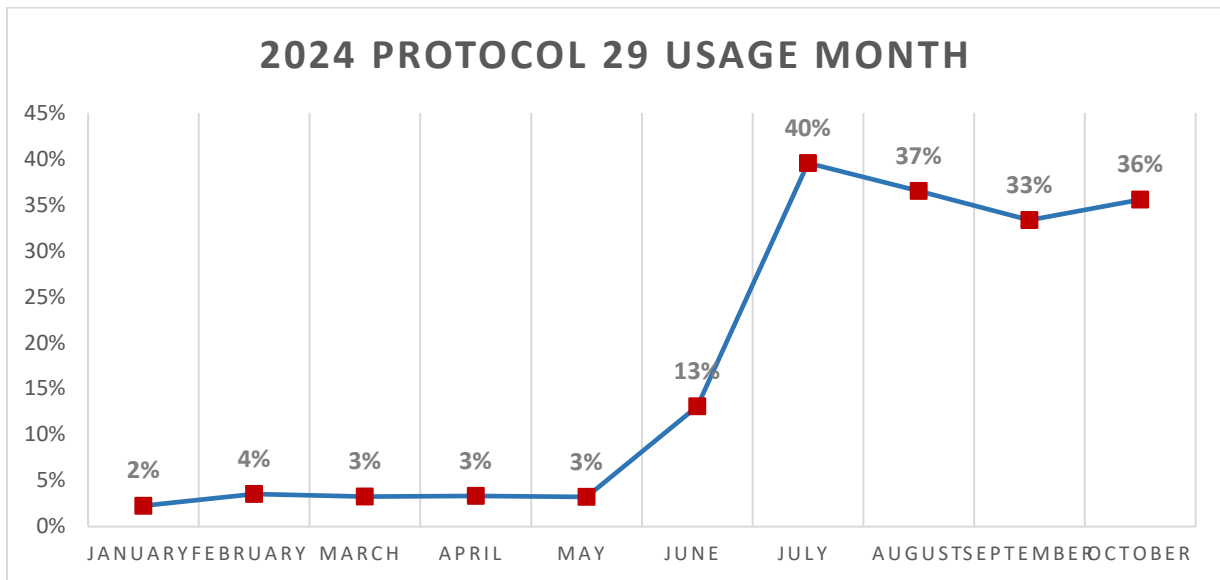


2024 Dispatch at Send (Non Call-Taker)
